

Developed a "prototype" Hybrid Raman microscope to assist diagnosis in the hospital

<u>Features:</u> high degree of automation easy use (for non-Raman experts), Daylight use, table-top size, no special infrastructure

> Easy sample mounting Al-assisted interpretation



Improved certainty of diagnosis results in more precise therapy choice Improved patient care (better treatment, faster recovery to mobility, reduced sick-time)
