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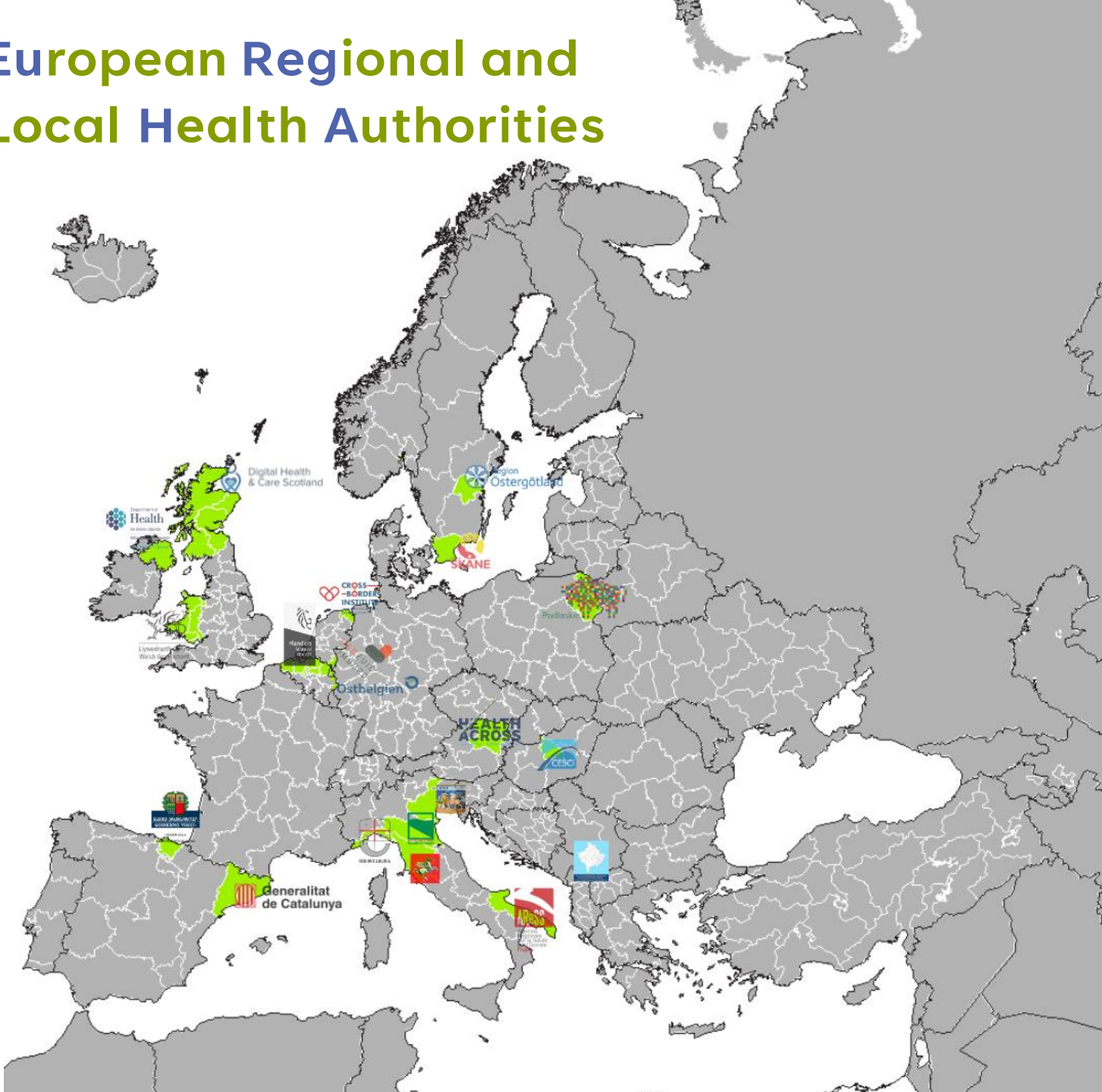
European Regional and Local Health Authorities

- Secretariat of the CoR's Interregional Group on Health and Wellbeing

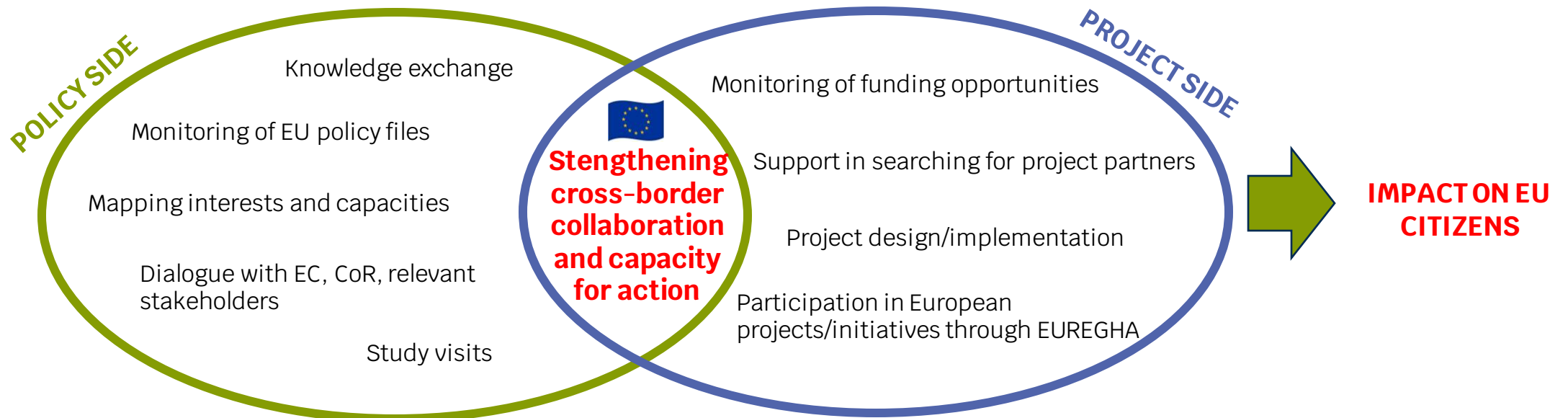
