Sustainability and competiveness

- Sustainability is far more than climate policy culture, societies, identity, population

Main recommendations for new COM

- Break down the obstacles constraining effective use of EU-conneted policy tools
- Let competitors to find their way to win
 - Let companies to create value (Investors and Buyers are the key \bullet stakeholders, constrain not contributing parties to interfere)
 - Let local, regional and national governments to innovate policy (constrain EU level recommendations and coordinations)
- Redefine concept of sustainability it is far more than climate ightarrowEuropean values are to be sustained
